(Commonly known as BTC, J.B.T., D.Ed. and Diploma in Education)

So, it is very necessary to be adequately equipped with resources that will make the teacher a perfect role model to the students. To achieve this, D.El.Ed was introduced, which will teach a person about teaching and the various aspects associated with teaching. Once a person completes the D. El.Ed training, then he is awarded with a D.El.Ed degree.

COURSE DETAIL

The Diploma in Elementary Education Programme, generally known as D.El.Ed., is a professional course offered for those interested in pursuing career in teaching & it prepares teachers for elementary stage (classes I-VIII).

Duration

The D.El.Ed. course is of two academic year. There shall be 200 teaching days including practice teaching in schools for every trainee.

Eligibility Criteria for Students

As per NCTE norms, a candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in Higher Secondary examination(+2). A relaxation of 5% is granted to the candidate belonging to reserved categories namely SC, ST, OBC and also for physically handicapped as per letter no. 01/ व 1-05/2004 (खण्ड) 1386 dated 03.08.12 of HRD Department, Jharkhand Government.

Length of Course

The course is of two academic year duration. There shall be at least 200 teaching days in a year exclusively out of which every trainee shall be required to undergo internship-in-teaching (including practice teaching and skill development) for at least 4 weeks and 16 weeks in 1st and 2nd year respectively.

Medium of Instruction

Medium of instruction will be in English & Hindi except in language paper.

Intake

Only 100 students will be admitted in one academic year. Reservation policy of the Government of Jharkhand will be followed.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

How to Apply

Application forms can be obtained from the college office. It is to be duly filled in and signed by the candidate. Incomplete application is subject to rejection. Candidates have to submit the application form along with required documents as written below -

- Attested photocopy of the Matriculation/ICSE/CBSE pass certificate showing the Date of Birth.
- Attested photocopy of the Matriculation/ICSE/CBSE mark sheet.
- Attested photocopy of mark sheet of I.A/I.Sc./I.Com./+2 to last achieved degree.

- Three recent colour passport size photograph to be pasted on application form & admit card
- Two self addressed & stamped (Rs.40/-) envelopes of size 5"x8" for correspondence.
- Attested photocopy of caste certificate and residential certificate issued by authority not below the rank of SDO.

Application forms should be either submitted to the college office personally or sent through postal mail. All original certificates should be brought for verification by the concerned candidate at the time of admission. Incomplete and late application form or furnishing false information will be summarily rejected without giving information to the concerned candidates. In this connection no correspondence will be entertained.

Uniform

Uniform will be provided by the college.

Documents Required At the Time of Admission

Selected candidate called for admission must produce following documents in original:

- Mark Sheet from Matriculation to last received degree.
- Provisional/Final certificate from matriculation to Last Received degree.
- School/College / Department leaving certificate.
- Migration certificate of university from which the candidate received his last Bachelor / Master degree (if any).
- Caste Certificate of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- Seven copies of recent passport size and three copies of recent stamp size photographs same as pasted in application form.
- N.C.C./Sports/Physically handicapped certificate, if any.
- Residential certificate.
- No objection certificate from the employer, if any.
- Affidavit as per format given in prospectus or provided by B.C.E.



■ RULES AND REGULATION

Keeping in view the aims and aspiration of **Bharathi College of Education** certain rules and regulations have been framed to be strictly followed by trainees. These rules have been formulated not to bind the trainees within the premises but to make them understand the value and standard of discipline, which, when, followed meticulously by the trainees, help them to emerge into a more determined, matured and knowledgeable individual. A full hearted support from our trainees and guardians are thus solicited.

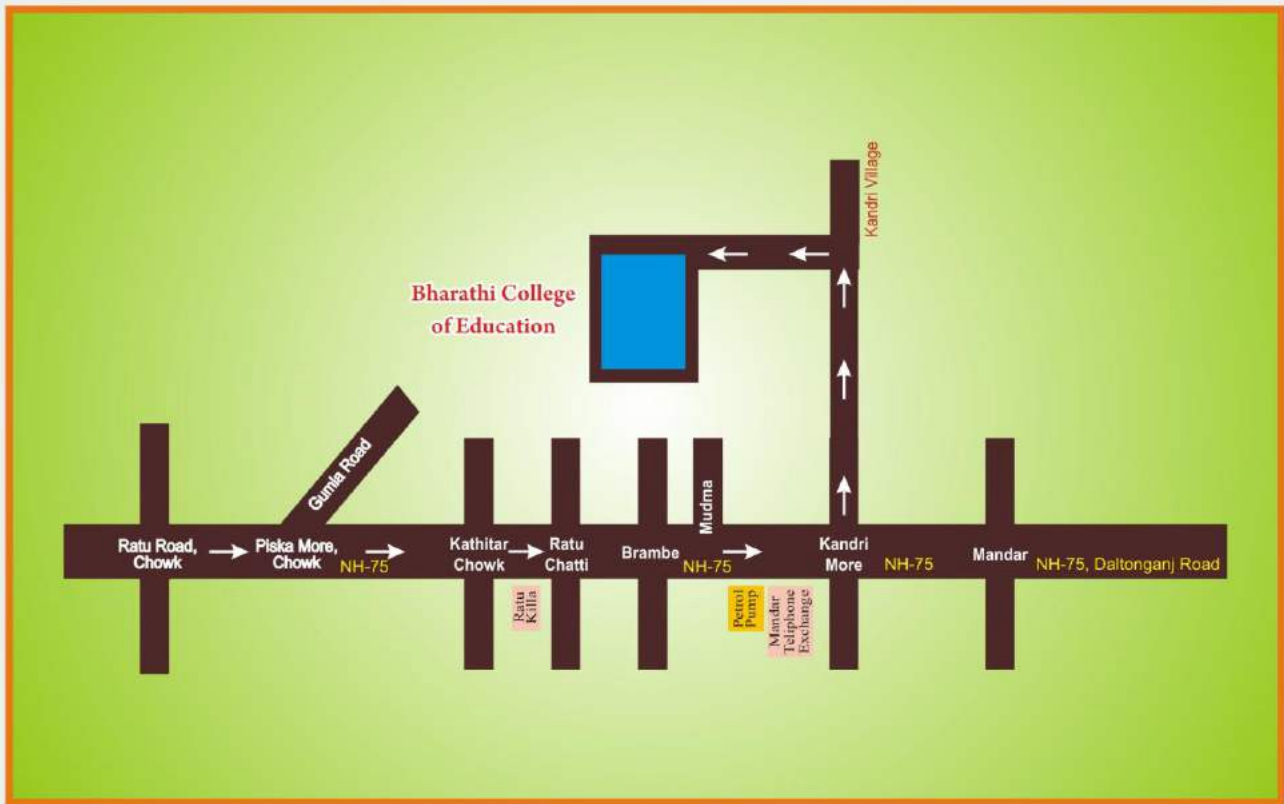
1. Students shall strictly comply with the rules and regulations of the college issued from time to time relating to their studies, examination, conduct and discipline.
2. The student, who secure admission on the basis of false certificate / marks sheet or on the basis of any misrepresenting of facts or illegal means, shall be summarily cancelled and all fees paid by him/her shall be forfeited. Legal action shall also be taken against them.
3. Candidates are required to enclose along with their application, the affidavit before a Notary Public stating that all information given by them is true.
4. Application accompanied with requisite documents/enclosure receive after the last date shall be summarily rejected.
5. No refund of fees will be made on withdrawal of admission under any circumstances.
6. In case the candidate fails to submit the required documents, admission shall be treated as cancelled and no request for refund of fees will be entertained under any circumstances.
7. If the applicant is employed, employers no objection certificate with proof of one year must be submitted during the time of admission.
8. Trainees can avail BCE's facilities only after the course commences and only till the course is running.
9. Trainees are liable to security checks on entry or exit from the college premises.
10. BCE will not be responsible for any loss of belonging left unattended by the trainees at the college premises.
11. Intake of any sort of intoxicating substance is strictly prohibited. Chewing of Paan/Gutka/Chewing Gum is also prohibited.
- 12. A trainee has to ensure at least 80% in Theory and 90% in Practice Teaching attendance for attaining eligibility for appearing in any examination.**
13. A medical certificate will be required if there are more than three days consecutive absence owing to illness.
14. All BCE properties have to be handled with care. Any damage or pilferage caused to BCE properties by any trainee will be appropriately charged for all deducted from the Caution Deposit Money (if any).
15. Trainees should strictly adhere to instructions regarding entry/exit regulations, parking of vehicles etc. They should not bring friends, visitors or relatives to the class rooms or practical rooms.
- 16. Ragging is banned in BCE and any one indulging in ragging process is likely to be punished appropriately.**
17. Use of mobile is strictly prohibited in the Campus Area.
18. All trainees are supposed to attend the classes in proper uniform suited for a gentleman / woman and as guided by B.C.E.
19. Male trainees must have short and properly groomed hair, clean and well trimmed nails. They should attend classes every day with a clean shave and polished shoe.
20. Female trainees must have properly groomed hair, clean and well trimmed nails without nail polish. Perfumes should not be used while attending theory or practical classes.
21. During class hours wearing the college Identity Card is compulsory.
22. These rules come into effect immediately and equally apply on all trainees of BCE.
23. BCE holds the right to introduce, alter, amend or change any or all the rules from time to time if found necessary.
24. Interpretation of these rules will always be made by the designated persons of BCE and shall be final and binding on all trainees.
25. For any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be at Ranchi Court only.
- 26. Discontinuance :**
 - (i) In case any trainee is found not paying his/her fees within 15 days from the due date he/she will fetch strong disciplinary measures leading to discontinuance.
 - (ii) If any trainees at their own opt to drop out from the course then the case will also be treated as discontinuance, in such a situation the course fee and other charges already paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
 - (iii) In case of absence for 15 consecutive days, the college must be informed of valid reason or the case will be treated as discontinuance.
 - (iv) In case of misconduct and violation of college norms, trainees may fetch disciplinary action leading to discontinuance.
